

FOX 15/THE ORCHARD Home Office Contest Official Rules

Contest Name: FOX 15/THE ORCHARD Home Office Contest

Station: KADN (15.1) Lafayette, Louisiana

KADN, its subsidiaries and affiliated companies (the "Company"), will conduct the contest substantially as described in these rules, and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

Description of Contest/Participation.

Dates of Contest: The contest will begin February 1, 2010 and end on or about March 5, 2010.

How to Play: Between February 1, and March 5, 2010 ("Entry Period") a promotional announcement will run on KADN urging viewers to watch THE OFFICE on KADN between 9:09PM and 10:07PM and look for the secret phrase. Viewers will then go to kادن.com to register and write in the secret phrase. Each day, the KADN promotions department will select one entrant with the correct secret phrase who will become eligible to win a Home Office prize pack including an iMac (21.5", 500GB hard drive, 4GB memory, 8x DL SuperDrive, NVIDIA GeForce 9400M graphics) including the iWork software suite and AppleCare protection plan and a custom-etched iPod Touch (8GB) total value of \$2,000. Only (1) prize per household from any of the Company's stations within any thirty (30) day period. Employees of the Company, this contest's participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, employees of other radio or television stations, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

The Company disclaims all liability for the inability for any delays, misdelivery, loss, or failure in the delivery of any item sent by mail, courier, express, electronic transmission, or other delivery method. The Company is not responsible for mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software malfunctions or failures of any kind, including "failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet or at any website or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online entrant's ability to participate in the contest, and any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in this contest.

Publicity. By participating, all participants and winner(s) grant the Company exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contest and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use.

Release. The participant and winner waive any and all claims of liability against FOX 15, its employees and agents, Communications Corporation of America, Inc., its employees and agents, and the officers, directors, employees, licensees and assignees of each, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the contest, or from the use of any prize.

Taxes.
